

**PROTECTIVE ORDER REGARDING RECORDED INTERVIEW OF A MINOR CHILD AND WITNESSES**

It is hereby ordered that the McHenry County State’s Attorney’s Office make available to defense counsel, upon payment or receipt of a blank DVD, a copy of the digitally recorded forensic interview of minor child and witnesses to be viewed subject to the following restrictions:

1. The forensic interviews shall not be exhibited, shown, disclosed or displayed to any person or used in any fashion by any party to this action except in a judicial proceeding or as may be directly necessary in the preparation of the defense of this action.
2. No copies of the forensic interviews shall be made by the defense except as may be directly necessary in the preparation of the defense of this case. The defense shall obtain leave of court prior to making any copies of the forensic interviews. At the conclusion of this case, the defense shall account for any copies.
3. The defendant may personally review the discovered materials in the direct presence and under the direct supervision of defense counsel, investigator or expert witness as may be necessary for the purposes of assisting in the defense of his case.
4. Under no circumstances shall the defendant personally be given any of the materials or copies of the materials to retain in his possession including cases involving pro se defendants.
5. This protective order shall be applicable to the defendant, any attorney for the defendant, any investigator, expert witness, agent or representative of the defendant.
6. A copy of this protective order shall accompany any copy made of the discovered materials and the recipient shall sign an acknowledgement that such person has read the order and agrees to be bound thereby. (See exhibit “A”) This signed form shall be filed with the court by defense counsel.
7. Any violation of this order shall result in sanctions by this court, including contempt, and may be punishable by state or federal law.
8. This order shall continue and shall apply whether the case is pending before a trial or post trial proceedings.
